Dear Colleague:

The Office of Victim Services is pleased to notify victim assistance programs about the availability of funding through the Ursula Forem Domestic Violence Program Employment Fellowship offered by the NYS Office for the Prevention of Domestic Violence (OPDV).

OPDV is accepting proposals from NYS domestic violence programs that are licensed and/or approved by the Office of Children and Family Services to hire recent college graduates (2012-1015) or current graduate students to work for the domestic violence program and collaborate with OPDV.

OPDV will fund two grants, up to a total of \$75,000, with a maximum of \$37,500 annually per award. The funds will be available to cover salary and fringe benefits for two years.
