The New York State Office of Victim Services (OVS) is pleased to announce 2015 National Crime Victim's Rights Week Community Awareness Project (NCVRW CAP) funding opportunity. Under a cooperative agreement with the federal Office for Victims of Crime (OVC), the National Association for VOCA Assistance Administrators (NAVAA) will reimburse at least 60 communities for up to \$5,000 each to promote crime victims' rights and services during National Crime Victims' Rights Week, April 19 – 25, 2015. We are pleased to announce the availability of funds earlier this year in order to afford recipients more time to plan and implement their projects.

The deadline for application submission is **Friday, August 1, 2014**. NAVAA will again be conducting a webinar for applicants to help them submit strong applications.
